Tropical Butterfly House – Wildlife Conservation Park

Dear Parents / Carers,

We have organised a visit to the Tropical Butterfly House in North Anston on Wednesday 20th March 2024 for FS2 and all FS1 pupils. We will be travelling to the venue by coach. The children will tour the park to see many animals including spectacular birds, amazing mammals and beautiful butterflies. We will also have the opportunity to get up close and personal with super slimy and creepy crawly minibeasts in a guided talk, as part of our minibeasts topic this half term! This trip will support our Understanding the World objective – to explore the natural world.

In order to comply with the criteria, set down in “The Education Act 1996”, to cover the cost of this visit, we are requesting a contribution of £13.50 per pupil. The payment should be made on-line via School Gateway on or before Wednesday 13th March 2024, however cash or cheque payments, can be made at the School Office. **Cheques should be made payable to Aston Community Education Trust.** The sum required is not compulsory, however, if sufficient payments are not received to cover the cost of the visit, we reserve the right to cancel the visit.

On the day of the visit (Wednesday 20th March 2024), we will be leaving school at 9:30am, therefore your child needs to arrive at school at **8:40am**, in order for registration to take place before leaving. We will arrive back at school for approximately 3:00pm. The majority of this visit will take place outside so please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather conditions for example a waterproof coat, hat, gloves and sensible shoes for walking in.

Pupils who take part in educational visits arranged by Springwood Junior Academy are representing the school to the community at large, and we do, of course, expect the highest standards of behaviour and that students comply with relevant Health and Safety Procedures/Risk Assessments. If, prior to the commencement of the visit, your son/daughter is involved in any serious incident that may indicate that they may be a risk to themselves or anyone else, the school reserves the right to withdraw them from the visit, and this may result in the loss of any/all monies paid, if we are unable to obtain a refund or fill the place. By giving consent for your child to take part in this visit, you are agreeing that they will adhere to these conditions.
